Penalties System

Penalties for players

The standard system described in WMF worldwide international sport rules chapter 2.3.18 is used in the team. Referees have the possibility to skip the pre-warning level in case of severe or tactical violations. All penalties are also announced via loudspeakers.

Penalties for coaches

For coaches, the standard penalty system described in WMF worldwide international sport rules chapter 2.3.19 is used throughout the entire tournament.

Referees have the possibility to skip the pre-warning level in case of severe or tactical violations.
